






Today, our flagship initiatives driving change:

संगिनी EMPOWERING RURAL GIRLS & WOMEN

Now in over 700 rural locations, Sangini is tackling menstrual hygiene taboos by providing pads at ₹2 and installing dispensers and incinerators. The goal: cut dropout rates by 50%, absenteeism by 30%, and improve health, dignity, and confidence.



Shri Om Prakash Choudhary, Advisor of Board Director of NOBA GSR, graciously received the CSR fund support from State Bank of India, marking a significant step towards expanding our social impact initiatives.

Our **Mobile Cool Storage Units** help farmers reduce post-harvest losses by up to 40%, extend shelf life by many weeks, and increase incomes by 25%, expanding their access to markets and reducing distress.

MENSTRUAL HYGIENE MANAGEMENT INITIATIVE

GROUND IMPACT REPORT

Empowering Rural Girls and Women with Dignity, Health, and Awareness

BACKGROUND

In many rural parts of India, menstruation remains a taboo subject. Lack of awareness, access to affordable sanitary products, and poor infrastructure contribute to high school absenteeism and even dropouts among adolescent girls. Women and girls often resort to unhygienic practices, leading to infections and long-term health issues.

Recognizing this deep-rooted challenge, **NOBA GSR** launched the **Sangini** Initiative, a nationwide menstrual hygiene management program focused on awareness, access, affordability, and dignity.



INTERVENTION

Sangini combines community education, low-cost sanitary pad distribution, and deployment of technology in schools and rural clusters. The initiative also partners with local health educators and NGOs to ensure sustainable adoption of hygiene practices.



KEY FEATURES OF THE PROGRAM

- ◆ **Sanitary Pad Vending Machines:** Installed in schools and community centers for easy access.
- ◆ **Incinerators:** Installed to promote safe disposal of used pads.
- ◆ **Awareness Campaigns:** Menstrual health education through sessions, street plays, and materials in local languages.
- ◆ **Affordability:** Sanitary pads available at subsidized cost of ₹2, making them accessible to even the most underprivileged.





ACHIEVEMENTS & IMPACT

- 👉 Over 2 lakh girls and women impacted through sustained hygiene awareness and access to products.
- 📍 Active in 700+ schools across multiple rural regions.
- 📈 Reduced absenteeism and dropout rates in secondary schools due to improved menstrual health management.
- 👩 Trained 200+ local women volunteers and teachers as health ambassadors in villages and schools.
- 👉 Improved health outcomes and awareness among adolescent girls, fostering a culture of openness and care.

INTEGRATED HYGIENE ECOSYSTEM

End-to-End Solution for Menstrual Health

Sangini does more than just provide sanitary pads—it builds a self-sustaining hygiene ecosystem by combining education, infrastructure (vending machines + incinerators), and community involvement. This integrated approach has become a model for scale and replication, especially in government and NGO school networks.

Empowering Women Farmers through Innovation in Post-Harvest Management

The Samvardhan Mobile Cool Storage Unit Initiative by NOBA GSR aims to revolutionize post-harvest management for. This innovative project addresses the challenges faced by farmers, such as the lack of cold storage facilities, which forces them to sell their perishable produce like mushrooms, watermelon, cauliflower, and cabbage at exploitative prices, often leading to financial losses.

Background and Objective

The initiative was conceptualized under the guidance of NOBA GSR Board Advisor Shri Om Prakash Choudhary and launched in April 2025 in partnership with Agri-tech innovator BMH Transmotion. The project aims to empower women farmers by providing sustainable, mobile cold storage units equipped with **Internet of Things (IoT)** technology to enhance preservation and reduce spoilage. The primary goal is to minimize post-harvest losses, improve market access, and ultimately increase the farmers' income by enabling them to store and sell their produce at favorable prices.



Innovative Technology and Features

Samvardhan units are designed as solar-powered, mobile cold storage solutions that can reach farm gates, reducing logistical burdens. The units incorporate air circulation systems, ethylene gas management, and IoT-based monitoring, allowing women farmers to maintain optimal storage conditions efficiently. The technology's mobility ensures that it reaches rural women farmers who lack access to traditional cold storage facilities. Additionally, the units are user-friendly, requiring minimal maintenance, which makes them accessible to local women without technical backgrounds.



Research and Community Engagement

NOBA GSR conducted a comprehensive **baseline survey** in Khunti to understand the socio-economic and environmental factors affecting mushroom production. The findings revealed that women farmers, despite being actively involved in agriculture, lacked decision-making power, access to modern techniques, and reliable storage solutions. The survey identified critical issues such as high spoilage rates, fluctuating prices, and limited market access. These insights shaped the Samvardhan initiative to be community-driven, addressing the core challenges faced by women cultivators.



Building a Sustainable Future

Samvardhan is not just a storage solution; it is a movement to restore dignity and economic freedom to women farmers. The success in Khunti has encouraged NOBA GSR to plan replication in other districts through CSR partnerships and FPO collaborations. The project aims to provide technology support, IoT integration, and continuous research to empower agricultural organizations working toward sustainable farming practices.

Conclusion

By leveraging technology and community involvement, Samvardhan is setting a precedent for sustainable post-harvest management. NOBA GSR remains committed to supporting agricultural organizations by offering technology assistance, conducting research, and fostering innovation to make a tangible difference in the lives of small and marginal farmers. The project exemplifies how integrating technology with grassroots efforts can create scalable, impactful solutions, ensuring better livelihoods and sustainable agricultural practices.

Under our environmental wing, Netarhat Vasudha, we adopted the White Peacock Enclosure at Patna Zoo, a tribute that binds remembrance with responsibility.

FROM GRIEF TO PURPOSE

This initiative was born from grief—but also from gratitude. We lost two of our beloved brothers, Ravi Ranjan Patel and Abhijeet, during the COVID-19 pandemic. Their absence left a silence, but we refused to let it become emptiness. Instead, we turned it into something that breathes, inspires, and heals. The white peacock, with its rare elegance and quiet majesty, became the perfect symbol—of their light, and of the legacy they left behind.



THREE YEARS OF LIVING COMMITMENT

Since 2021, NOBA GSR has supported the care and upkeep of the white peacocks at Patna Zoo. This long-term adoption reflects not just our love for nature, but also a deeper understanding—that nurturing life is one of the most meaningful ways to remember those we've lost.

Our commitment to wildlife conservation was recognized by the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of Bihar, a moment of collective honor for our entire NOBA GSR family. 
AN INVITATION TO THE WORLD
